The business will adopt the name 3Squared, inspired by their former gallery, and will operate under an LLC. With an established reputation and following in the art world, Akaash and Marina, former owners of 3Squared Gallery, once located at 351 W 24th Street for which opened in 2015 and operated for many years, were compelled to close their doors after the building was sold and later demolished. They have since transitioned into private art dealing.
